In addition, you must have a cumulative Financial Aid GPA of at least 2.0, a cumulative successful pace of completion of at least 67%, and remain within the 150% maximum time frame. When this is accomplished, your eligibility will be reinstated. **STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING THE OFFICE OF FINANCIAL AID WHEN THEY BELIEVE THEY HAVE REGAINED ELIGIBILITY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.**
