

Federal Work Study Opportunities

Ranger College participates in the Federal College Work-Study Program which is sponsored jointly by the federal government and Ranger College. Students must submit a FAFSA and have unmet financial need to be eligible for work-study. Student assistants are employed in faculty and administrative offices, laboratories, the library, student services and community service jobs. Because all wages are on an hourly basis, work schedules are arranged around class schedules. Funds are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until funds are depleted. Students must request work-study by FAFSA or in person.

Work-Study Areas

1. **Instruction:** Computer lab, Science lab, Tutoring, Faculty (secretarial), Baseball, Softball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Men's and Women's Soccer, Rodeo, Women's Volleyball, Nursing
2. **Academic Support:** Library, Dean of Instruction, Comanche Center
3. **Student Services:** Registrar, Financial Aid, Counselor, Student Activities, Dean of Students
4. **Institutional Support:** Administration, Business Office, Personnel Office, PBX Switchboard, Cashier, Institutional Effectiveness
5. **Operation and Maintenance:** Custodial, Cleaning, Building, Welding maintenance
6. **Auxiliary Enterprises:** Dorm Supervisors, Cleaning of dorms, Athletics, Bookstore
