Minimum requirements – Doctorate in Biology preferred, Master’s degree required with **at least 18 graduate hours** in Biology and two years directly related post secondary instructional work experience. Candidate must be able to teach Biology, Anatomy and Physiology I and II, and Microbiology.

Position Summary- Successful candidates are required to teach traditional lecture, online and dual credit courses. Assignments may include day and/or evening sections, as well as sections at one or more of Ranger College’s off-campus sites and working with ITV technology. In addition to teaching a 15 semester hour course load, full-time faculty members follow departmental syllabi; collaborate with colleagues in the selection of textbooks, software, and other instructional material; maintain students' records; submit official records and reports as required; implement the College’s plan for assessment of student learning; attend meetings; maintain required office hours; and perform other assigned departmental, divisional, and college duties. The successful candidate must possess demonstrated skills in successfully working with diverse student populations, excellent interpersonal and communication skills, and computer skills to support teaching and learning.

Schedule and Start Date-This is a nine-month, tenure track contract position. Start date to be August 16, 2010. Opportunities for summer teaching exist.
