Dear Prospective Student,

Thank you for your interest in the Ranger College Vocational Nursing Certificate Program at Brown, Eastland, Comanche, and Erath counties. To begin the process, you will need to complete an application to Ranger College online. You must meet all the guidelines for acceptance into Ranger College. You will select LVN as the program of choice on the application.

Prerequisites for the VN Program include a high school diploma or equivalent, completion of the Test of Essential Academic Skill (TEAS), and completion of an Anatomy and Physiology (A&P) course. The A&P course may be a college level course or a certificate course offered here at Ranger College. You must achieve at least a "C" in A&P course and a score of at least 50 on the TEAS exam.

Go to <https://www.atitesting.com/Solutions/pre-program/TEAS.aspx> to schedule and pay for your TEAS test. The TEAS test will be offered at the Ranger College Early campus beginning 18 January 2018. Contact Mrs. Angie Gomez at 325-203-5013 to sign up for the next A&P class beginning 17 January 2018. It is also held at the Early campus.

To complete your application you will need to follow all admission criteria posted on the Ranger College website. You will need to submit to Mrs. Angela Gomez, VN Program Administrative Assistant a diploma, complete immunization record, current physical exam, letters of reference, and an American Heart Association Health Care Provider CPR card. A Criminal Background Check and Drug Screen are required for full admission to the program. You will be given information on how to complete those screenings during your application process.
