TDLR & Ranger College Cosmetology Background Check Policy

I understand that the State of Texas will conduct a criminal background check on all licensees in the state of Texas before a license is granted. The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulations (TDLR) requires that all persons applying for a cosmetology license have a criminal background check (Texas Occupational Code §53.025) below:

- (a) Each licensing authority shall issue guidelines relating to the practice of the licensing authority under this chapter. The guidelines must state the reasons a particular crime is considered to relate to a particular license and any other criterion that affects the decisions of the licensing authority.
- (b) A state licensing authority that issues guidelines under this section shall file the guidelines with the secretary of state for publication in the Texas Register.
- (c) A local or county licensing authority that issues guidelines under this section shall post the guidelines at the courthouse for the county in which the licensing authority is located or publish the guidelines in a newspaper having countywide circulation in that county.
- (d) Amendments to the guidelines, if any, shall be issued annually.

TDLR requests that all applications visit their website at www.tdlr.texas.gov and go to the link for "Laws and Rules". This site also gives the specifics of the Criminal Conviction Guidelines, which contains information about the process and the responsibilities of each applicant.

Ranger College provides equal educational opportunities for all qualified students regardless of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap. NOTICE OF POTENTIAL INELIGIBILITY FOR LICENSE

Texas law:

- restricts the issuance of occupational licenses based on a license applicant's criminal history; and
- authorizes the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR), in some cases, to consider a person convicted, even though the person was only on probation or community supervision without a conviction.

- If I have been convicted of an offense or placed on probation, I might not be eligible for an occupational license issued by TDLR after I complete this educational or training program;
 - TDLR's criminal history guidelines are available at www.tdlr.texas.gov/crimconvict.htm and include restrictions or guidelines TDLR uses to determine eligibility for an occupational license; and
- I have the right to request a criminal history evaluation letter from TDLR, which is explained in more detail at www.tdlr.texas.gov/crimhistoryeval.htm.

Section 53.152, Occupations Code, requires that notice be provided to each applicant and enrollee regardless of whether the applicant or enrollee has been convicted of an offense.

REFUND AND ORDERED PAYMENTS. State law requires TDLR to order an educational program provider to refund tuition, license application fees, and examination fees if:

- TDLR determines the provider failed to provide notice to me; and
- my license application was denied because of my criminal history.

TDLR Guidelines for Criminal Convictions (Texas Occupations Code, § 53.052(a))

Crimes involving prohibited sexual conduct or involving children as victims.

Reasons:

- 1. Licensees have direct contact with members of the general public often in settings with no one else present.
- 2. A person with a predisposition for crimes involving prohibited sexual conduct or involving children as victims would have the opportunity to engage in further similar conduct.

Crimes against the person such as homicide, kidnapping and assault.

Reasons:

- 1. Licensees have direct contact with persons in situations that have potential for confrontational behavior.
- 2. A person with a predisposition of a violent response would pose a risk to the public.

Crimes involving illegal manufacture or delivery of a controlled substance.

Reasons:

- Licensees work in a business establishment under their control, that is difficult to monitor with customers constantly coming and going, sometimes lingering for varied periods of time, which would provide a person with a predisposition to sell controlled substances an effective cover of their selling of controlled substances.
- Licensees have exclusive access to customers for extended periods of time providing the
 opportunity for persons with predisposition to sell controlled substances the opportunity to
 persuade the uninitiated to buy a controlled substance.

Crimes involving human trafficking.

Reasons:

- 1. Victims of human trafficking often lack legal immigration status, money, and the ability to speak English fluently. Such persons are at particular risk of being compelled or forced to provide labor.
- 2. Customers of barbering or cosmetology services often receive services in private rooms closed off from public view at the direction of a licensee or a licensed establishment's owner or manager. This arrangement could provide an effective cover for the sale of licensed or unlicensed services by victims of human trafficking through forced labor at the direction of a licensee or a licensed establishment's owner or manager. Accordingly, barbering or cosmetology work could provide a licensee or a licensed establishment's owner or manager with a predisposition to exploit vulnerable workers through forced labor an effective cover for that exploitation.
- Regular access to a licensed establishment would provide licensees or a licensed establishment's owner or manager with a predisposition for and experience in human trafficking motivation to engage in further similar conduct to exploit victims of human trafficking through forced labor.
