Did You Know? Refund Policy

Students who officially drop a course or courses or officially withdraw from Ranger College and are enrolled in semester-length courses shall receive refunds of mandatory tuition and fees in excess of the minimum tuition as follows:

Fall and Spring Semesters

Prior to the first class day	100%
During the first fifteen class days	70%
During class days sixteen through twenty	25%
