

Dual-Credit High School Student EMT Information

Required courses for Juniors include Anatomy & Physiology and Medical Terminology. Seniors begin EMT coursework in the fall of their senior year.

Prerequisites: completed by the end of Junior year.

Senior year: Students will have the full school year to complete the program.

*Skills sessions will be held once a month at the RC Campus nearest the student. They may attend in Erath, Brown, or Eastland counties. An optional school visit by qualified instructors is available on a case-by-case basis.

Upon successful completion of Ranger's EMT program, the student will attend 96 hours of clinical rotations, 48 ED, 48 ambulance, as scheduled by Ranger College.

Students will then schedule and sit for the National Registry exam. Ranger staff can provide suggestions for test sites, but the ultimate responsibility for scheduling and attending lies with the student.
