



PRELIMINARY FALL 2023 TEXAS HIGHER EDUCATION ENROLLMENT DATA SHOWS RANGER COLLEGE HAD A 10.3% GROWTH IN ENROLLMENT FROM 2022 TO 2023. THIS WAS THE 7 TH HIGHEST GROWTH RATE AMONG COMMUNITY COLLEGES IN TEXAS. RC RECORDED ITS HIGHEST FALL ENROLLMENT IN FALL 2023 WITH A RECORD ENROLLMENT OF 2,485 STUDENTS.


