RANGER COLLEGE MEN'S TEAM WINS THEIR 4TH STRAIGHT

RANGER COLLEGE DOMINATED SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE IN A BASKETBALL GAME ON NOVEMBER 30, 2023, WITH A FINAL SCORE OF 87-63. THE GAME TOOK PLACE AT SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE AT 6:00 PM.

RANGER COLLEGE STARTED STRONG IN THE FIRST HALF, SCORING 47 POINTS COMPARED TO SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE'S 27 POINTS. ASJON ANDERSON FROM RANGER COLLEGE WAS THE TOP SCORER IN THE GAME, CONTRIBUTING 26 POINTS. HE MADE 8 OF HIS 14 FIELD GOALS, INCLUDING 5 THREE-POINTERS. DERRICK DANIELS ALSO HAD AN IMPRESSIVE PERFORMANCE, SCORING 14 POINTS.

SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE STRUGGLED TO KEEP UP WITH RANGER COLLEGE'S OFFENSE. DALANTE SHANNON WAS THE LEADING SCORER FOR SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE WITH 18 POINTS, FOLLOWED BY CAYLEN GOFF-BROWN WITH 11 POINTS. HOWEVER, THEIR EFFORTS WERE NOT ENOUGH TO OVERCOME RANGER COLLEGE'S DOMINANCE.

IN TERMS OF SHOOTING PERCENTAGES, RANGER COLLEGE HAD AN IMPRESSIVE FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE OF 57.6%. THEY MADE 34 OF THEIR 59 FIELD GOAL ATTEMPTS. THEY WERE ALSO SUCCESSFUL FROM BEYOND THE ARC, MAKING 10 OF THEIR 21 THREE-POINT ATTEMPTS. SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE HAD A FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE OF 42.9% AND MADE 24 OF THEIR 56 FIELD GOAL ATTEMPTS. THEY MADE 6 OF THEIR 15 THREE-POINT ATTEMPTS.

BOTH TEAMS STRUGGLED WITH TURNOVERS, WITH RANGER COLLEGE COMMITTING 14 TURNOVERS AND SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE COMMITTING 13 TURNOVERS. HOWEVER, RANGER COLLEGE'S STRONG SHOOTING AND OFFENSIVE PERFORMANCE ALLOWED THEM TO MAINTAIN A SIGNIFICANT LEAD THROUGHOUT THE GAME.

THE GAME WAS NOT WITHOUT FOULS, WITH SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE PLAYERS BEING CALLED FOR FIVE TECHNICAL FOULS. DALANTE SHANNON RECEIVED TWO TECHNICAL FOULS, WHILE JAYDEN PARKER AND CAYLEN GOFF-BROWN EACH RECEIVED ONE.

OVERALL, RANGER COLLEGE'S DOMINANT PERFORMANCE LED THEM TO A DECISIVE VICTORY OVER SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE. THEIR EFFICIENT SHOOTING AND STRONG OFFENSIVE PLAY WERE KEY FACTORS IN THEIR SUCCESS. SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE WILL NEED TO REGROUP AND IMPROVE ITS PERFORMANCE IN FUTURE GAMES TO BOUNCE BACK FROM THIS LOSS.

IN THE WINDOW THIS WEEK: WE END THE SEMESTER STILL LOOKING AT UFOS. DID YOU KNOW THAT IN APRIL 2022, A FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST FILED BY THE U.S. ARM OF THE BRITISH TABLOID THE SUN FOUR YEARS EARLIER PROMPTED THE U.S. DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY TO RELEASE 1,574 PAGES OF "UFO-RELATED" MATERIAL TO THE NEWSPAPER. THE SUN REPORTED THAT THE MATERIAL ORIGINATING FROM THE ADVANCED AEROSPACE THREAT IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM (AATIP), A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE PROGRAM THAT OPERATED BETWEEN 2007 AND 2012, INCLUDED 42 MEDICAL CASES AND 300 UNPUBLISHED CASES OF HUMANS SUSTAINING INJURIES AFTER ALLEGED ENCOUNTERS WITH "ANOMALOUS VEHICLES," INCLUDING UFOS.
