RANGER COLLEGE DEFEATED HILL COLLEGE WITH A FINAL SCORE OF 84-73 IN A BASKETBALL GAME HELD ON FEBRUARY 7, 2024. THE GAME WAS CLOSELY CONTESTED, WITH RANGER COLLEGE TAKING AN EARLY LEAD IN THE FIRST HALF AND MAINTAINING IT THROUGHOUT THE GAME.

IN TERMS OF INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCES, FOR RANGER COLLEGE, <u>ASJON ANDERSON</u>
WAS THE STANDOUT PERFORMER, SCORING A TEAM-HIGH 23 POINTS. HE WAS EFFICIENT
FROM THE FIELD, MAKING 6 OF HIS 11 FIELD GOAL ATTEMPTS AND CONVERTING 9 OF 11
FREE THROWS. <u>DEMARCO BETHEA</u> ALSO HAD A NOTABLE PERFORMANCE, SCORING 17
POINTS AND GRABBING 10 REBOUNDS.

GOB GOB WAS THE LEADING SCORER FOR HILL COLLEGE WITH 18 POINTS. HE HAD A SOLID SHOOTING PERFORMANCE, MAKING 6 OF HIS 16 FIELD GOAL ATTEMPTS, INCLUDING 2 OF 4 FROM THE THREE-POINT RANGE. BENJAMIN EZEAGU ALSO HAD A STRONG GAME FOR HILL COLLEGE, CONTRIBUTING 16 POINTS AND GRABBING 7 REBOUNDS.

IN TERMS OF TEAM STATISTICS, RANGER COLLEGE HAD THE ADVANTAGE IN SHOOTING PERCENTAGE, CONVERTING 52.6% OF THEIR FIELD GOAL ATTEMPTS COMPARED TO HILL COLLEGE'S 43.5%. RANGER COLLEGE ALSO HAD A SLIGHTLY BETTER THREE-POINT SHOOTING PERCENTAGE, MAKING 33.3% OF THEIR ATTEMPTS COMPARED TO HILL COLLEGE'S 30.8%. HOWEVER, HILL COLLEGE HAD A HIGHER FREE THROW PERCENTAGE, MAKING 78.9% OF THEIR ATTEMPTS COMPARED TO RANGER COLLEGE'S 66.7%.

REBOUNDING WAS RELATIVELY EVEN BETWEEN THE TWO TEAMS, WITH RANGER COLLEGE GRABBING 31 REBOUNDS COMPARED TO HILL COLLEGE'S 34. HOWEVER, RANGER COLLEGE HAD MORE ASSISTS, RECORDING 20 COMPARED TO HILL COLLEGE'S 14. BOTH TEAMS HAD A SIMILAR NUMBER OF TURNOVERS, WITH HILL COLLEGE COMMITTING 13 AND RANGER COLLEGE COMMITTING 10.

OVERALL, RANGER COLLEGE'S STRONG SHOOTING AND BALANCED SCORING HELPED

THEM SECURE THE VICTORY OVER HILL COLLEGE.
