On Monday, April 8, 2024, a total solar eclipse will be visible in North America for the first time since 2017. The next solar eclipse will not be visible in the contiguous U.S. until 2044 according to NASA.

Ranger College is in an area that will receive 98.6% coverage



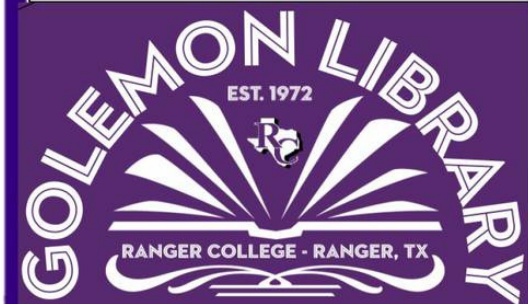

RANGER COLLEGE ATHLETICS SPOTLIGHT

COMING INTO WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON'S DOUBLEHEADER AGAINST CONFERENCE RIVAL, HILL COLLEGE, COACH NORWOOD'S RANGER COLLEGE BASEBALL TEAM WAS SITTING IN THIRD PLACE IN THE NORTHERN TEXAS JUNIOR COLLEGE ATHLETIC CONFERENCE WITH AN OVERALL RECORD OF 23-13. RIDING A 2-GAME WINNING STREAK AND COMING OFF THE MONTH OF MARCH WHICH SAW THE RANGERS POST ANOTHER WINNING MONTH, THE RANGERS KEPT THEIR HOT STREAK ROLLING AGAINST HILL.

DESPITE TRAILING BY AS MANY AS SIX RUNS, THE RANGERS RALLIED TO DEFEAT HILL IN GAME ONE OF THE DOUBLEHEADER 12-11. BYRON MADERO EARNED THE WIN FOR RANGER ALLOWING ONLY FOUR HITS AND THREEE RUNS OVER THREE AND TWO-THIRDS INNINGS WHILE KYLE HUGHES PICKED UP THE SAVE.

IN GAME TWO OF THE TWO-GAME SET VERSUS HILL COLLEGE, THE RANGERS DOMINATED FROM THE START ON ROUTE TO AN 18-7 VICTORY. JACKSON DILLINGHAM DROVE IN SEVEN RUNS ON TWO HITS INCLUDING A GRAND SLAM IN THE EIGHTH INNING.
