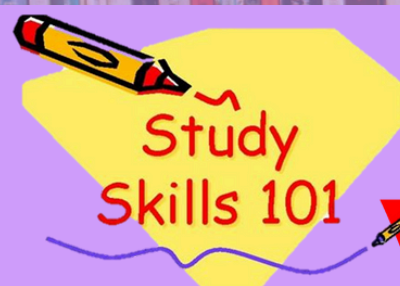
MORE THAN JUST BOOKS BY GOLEMON LIBRARY, ASSISTANT LIBRARIAN, HELEN COZART
