

APRIL IS NATIONAL POETRY MONTH AND EVERY YEAR GOLEMON LIBRARY SPONSORS A POETRY CONTEST FOR STUDENTS. THIS YEAR'S THEME IS THE FUTURE. I EXPECT STUDENTS HAVE A LOT TO SAY ABOUT THE FUTURE AND AM LOOKING FORWARD TO EVEN MORE ENTRIES COMING OVER THE NEXT COUPLE OF WEEKS. WE WILL STOP ACCEPTING ENTRIES ON APRIL 24 SO THE JUDGES HAVE A LITTLE TIME TO MAKE THEIR DECISIONS. FIRST PRIZE IS \$50 AMAZON GIFT CARD. SECOND PRIZE IS \$25 GIFT CARD AND THIRD PRIZE IS A \$10 GIFT CARD. LAST YEAR A DONOR DOUBLED THE PRIZES, SO MAYBE WE HAVE SOMETHING SPECIAL TO LOOK FORWARD TO THIS YEAR.
