

Tracking Tool Guidelines

TDaP (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)

Proof of TDaP booster within the last 10 years. The document will be rejected if the above is not provided. This immunization date must be valid for the entire upcoming semester. If your most recent dose of this vaccination will expire during the upcoming semester, please renew and submit an up to date TDaP prior to the semester start.

MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)

Proof of two doses of vaccination for MMR **OR** positive titers proving immunity against Mumps, Measles, and Rubella with each listed separately on the record. The document will be rejected if the above is not provided.

Hepatitis B

Proof of three doses of vaccination for Hepatitis B **OR** a positive titer proving immunity against Hepatitis B. Proof of the 1st dose must be given before matriculation into the program. Dose schedule: The 2nd dose should be administered at least 1 month after the 1st dose, and the 3rd dose should be administered 3- 6 months after the 1st. The document will be rejected if the above is not provided.

Varicella

Proof of two doses of vaccination for Varicella **OR** a positive titer proving immunity against Varicella. Students are required to submit lab report showing the actual numeric value of titer. Notes from parents, doctors, or any other entities stating the student had chickenpox as a child will be rejected. The document will be rejected if the above is not provided.

Meningitis

Proof of one meningitis vaccination required if student is 21 years of age or younger at the start of the program per Ranger College requirements. The document will be rejected if the above is not provided.

Tuberculosis (TB) Testing

Proof of 2 Negative TB Skin Tests dated within the past year. Test results must be reported as “# of mm” induration in addition to “positive” or “negative” response.

OR proof of a Chest X-ray (CXR) dated within the past 3 years may be submitted. Annual TB screening form must accompany the CXR report and must be completed each subsequent year.

Annual TB test must be submitted in subsequent years. The documents will be rejected if one of the above is not provided.

Seasonal Flu

Proof of receiving the seasonal flu shot or a written statement from a physician that the student has an allergy related to the flu shot. Flu shots must be received after September 1st of the current year and documentation must be submitted by October 25th. The document will be rejected if the above is not provided.

CPR Certification

Upload a copy of the certification (when applicable, include the front & the back of the document). Certification expires after 2 years. To be accepted, the certificate must contain the following information: your name, the course/training completed, who it was conducted by, the date of completion, the time of validation, and certificate ID number. The next action date will be set based on the expiration date on the certificate/card. This certification must be valid for the entire upcoming semester. If your CPR certification will expire during the upcoming semester, please renew and submit an up to date CPR Certification prior to the semester start. **American Heart Association BLS Training ONLY*. The document will be rejected if the above is not provided.

Background Check

Board of Nursing (BON) requires a Federal background check before NCLEX testing. After acceptance, the BON will provide an access code for fingerprinting via personal email. The fingerprint receipt must be submitted to the nursing office. BON will send either a letter or a “Blue Card” (a blue postcard) upon clearance. Upload a copy of either the BON letter or “Blue Card”.
