1. **TAX RETURN FILERS**—**Important Note:** If you (or your spouse, if married) filed, or will file, an amended 2016 IRS tax return, you must contact the financial aid administrator before completing this section.

Instructions: Complete this section if you, the student, filed or will file a 2016 income tax return with the IRS. *The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool that is part of FAFSA on the Web. If you have not already used the tool, go to FAFSA.gov, log in to your FAFSA record, select "Make FAFSA Corrections," and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form.
